

FAQ's:

What's included in the registration fee?

The registration fee covers both halves of the season and your child's soccer uniform which is theirs to keep. It also covers fields and referee fees. (u8 and up)

Do I need to buy any equipment for my child?

The only thing that is required is **shin guards**. You **must** buy your own, the league does not supply them. Soccer cleats are **highly** recommended but not required to play.

How long is the season?

Our season consists of 20 games (weather permitting) broken down into two halves. The first half is in the fall and the second half is in the spring .

When does the first half start?

Games for the first half start after Labor Day

When are practices?

Practice schedules vary per each coach.

Where are the fields?

All of the game fields are in St. Clair Shores. Check our web site for schedules and field locations.

What is Scooter Shooters?

Scooter Shooters offers new players ages 3 ½ to 5 years old the chance to learn soccer basics. Important early skills such as ball control and safety will be taught. Each session is an hour long with the time divided between skills development and an inter-squad game. There are 8 sessions each half. This program is limited to the first 50 children that sign up.

What are the division age groups?

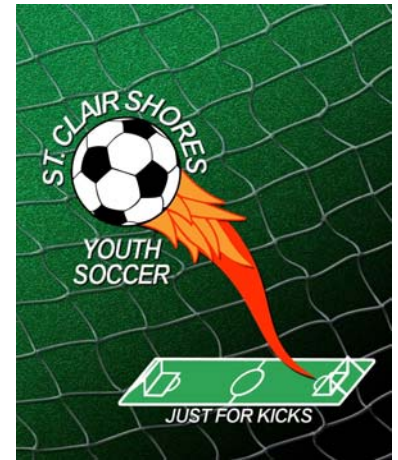
Under 6 (u6), Under 8 (u8), Under 10 (u10), Under 12 (u12) and Under 14 (u14)

Is this league co-ed?

Yes, all divisions in our league are co-ed.

What is Metro Travel?

Metro Travel is what we call our U12 and U14 divisions. These divisions play other rec teams from neighboring communities like Grosse Pointe and Roseville. There are home games and away games.



What are small sided games?

These are soccer games with fewer players competing on a smaller sized field. These are fun games that involve the players more because fewer players are sharing one ball.

Can I coach?

When's the picnic and does my child get a trophy?
